SSG Craig joined the Army in 1999 as a Medical Specialist. He faithfully served as a Medic for seven years. He started out his military career as a Medic in 2-2 Infantry, 1st Infantry Division. He served as a Scout Platoon Medic in both Germany and on his deployments to Kosovo. Upon leaving Germany, he was assigned as a Health Care Specialist at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. During that year, he decided to pursue his ambitions of becoming a flight medic. He was selected for and attended the Flight Medic Course and upon graduation, he was assigned to the 159th Medical Company (Air Ambulance) in Wiesbaden, Germany.
